

## Synopsis Conventions Illustrated

### Indicative

Present	x (verb)s / x is (verb)ed	amat / amâtur
Imperfect	x was (verb)ing / x was being (verb)ed	amâbat / amâbâtur
Future	x will (verb) / x will be (verb)ed	amâbit / amâbitur
Present Perfect	x has (verb)ed / x has been (verb)ed	amâvit / amâtus est
Past Perfect	x had (verb)ed / x had been (verb)ed	amâverat / amâtus erat
Future Perfect	x will have (verb)ed / x will have been (verb)ed	amâverit / amâtus erit

### Subjunctive

Present	let x (verb) / let x be (verb)ed	amet / amêtur
Imperfect	x would (verb) / x would be (verb)ed	amâret / amârêtur
Perfect	[I ask what] x has (verb)ed / [I ask who or what] has been (verb)ed	amâverit / amâtus sit
Past Perfect	x would have (verb)ed / x would have been (verb)ed	amâvisset / amâtus esset

### Participles

Present	(verb)ing	amâns
Past	[having been] (verb)ed [Deponents: having (verb)ed]	amâtus
Future	about to (verb) / about to be (verb)ed	amâtûrus / amandus

### Infinitives

Present	to (verb) / to be (verb)ed	amâre / amârî
Perfect	to have (verb)ed / to have been (verb)ed	amâvisse / amâtus esse
Future	to be about to (verb) / to be about to be (verb)ed	amâtûrus esse / amâtum îrî

### Imperatives

Present Sg.	(verb)! / be (verb)ed!	amâ / amâre
Present Pl.	(verb)! (pl) / be (verb)ed! (pl)	amâte / amâminî
